- 1.** The 80 car entry limit for NEFR 2021 has been lifted to 90 entries.
- 2.** Chris Regan is appointed Deputy Clerk of the Course. Inquiries should be done online where possible or can be given directly to Service In or MTC In controls. Forms are supplied in the back of the Route Book or from forms found attached to the Official Notice Board.
- 3.** The Friday Morning Parc Exposé will open at 8:30am, All cars are due in by 9:30am
The Official Start on Friday, July 30, 2021 will be at 10:31am.
The Saturday morning Parc Exposé will open at 7:00am, all cars are due in by 7:45am.
The Official Start on Saturday, July 31, 2021 will be at 8:16am.
- 4.** Restart after Retirement Notification of your intention to restart on the next leg of the rally can be done as per Section 6.3 of the ARA RCR's or by writing on your timecard noting your intention to rejoin the rally.
- 5.** The slow speed to trigger the Virtual Chicanes will be 20mph! The Quiet Zone speed limit is 25mph. It is your responsibility to understand the way the RallySafe Virtual Chicanes and the Quiet Zones work; RallySafe is the Judge of Fact.
- 6.** Refueling Zones at Sunday River and in Errol Service are part of the RGC's as you leave the "Service Out/RGC In" controls.
- 7.** Remember only small SUV type vehicles will be able to access the remote refuel locations at the Andover "Grimaldi Field" and the Wilson Mills DOT Lot.
- 8.** There will be a remote refuel before the South Arm stage and after the Icicle Brook stage at the Andover Grimaldi Field on Friday. For Saturday, there will be a remote refuel after each Sturtevant stage before you run Wilson Mills 1 & 2 at the Wilson Mills Dot Lot.
- 9.** The seeded draw will be done virtually after recce is complete at 9:00pm, July 29th, 2021. The Stewards Meeting will start with the virtual seeded draw and will be located at South Ridge Welcome Center.
- 10.** "O" Controls will be used for Recce and during the event. RallySafe will also be monitoring your speeds.

11. Important Recce Information!

Please read the section on Logging Trucks within the NEFR 2021 Supps. It is most important for everyone's safety! Your recce vehicle will have your competitor number on them. Logging Trucks are aware of your recce number, they will be judges of fact.

12. Recce Update

- a. Recce Instructions, including a suggested recce route, will be available at Recce Registration.
- b. If you decide to plan your own route for recce, the information supplied herein (overall map and time schedule with distances) should allow you to do that.
- c. Recce Registration will open two hours earlier on Wednesday July 28, 2021, at 5:00pm and will close at 10:00pm. If you can not make it by this time you must contact by email John Buffum: johnbuffum1@gmail.com.
- d. After you have completed Recce Registration, you may recce Concord Pond on Wednesday, July 28, 2021, between 6:00pm and 8:30pm.
- e. Thursdays on-stage recce access on July 29, 2021, will be from 6:00am until 8:00pm.
- f. Recce will be a maximum of two passes of each stage and will be monitored.
- g. Reverse recce traffic will be allowed on Concord Pond, South Arm, Beaver Pond, Sturtevant Short & Long and North Road stages.
- h. Sturtevant Short and Sturtevant Long are considered for recce purposes to be one stage, you may do these roads a maximum of two times.
